Targa Wrest Point seeks your support and co-operation in ensuring a traditional warm Tasmanian welcome to the many national and international visitors that will visit your immediate area as outlined above. Like Targa Tasmania, Targa Wrest Point brings thousands of visitors to our Island contributing millions of dollars to our state economy whilst promoting the Tasmanian brand around the world.

The roads detailed as bold black lines on the map found overleaf form part of the event's competitive stages and will be closed to the public for a maximum of four and a half hours. Just before the event, roadside signs will be placed and advertisements will appear in The Mercury newspaper detailing all road closure times. Bus and transport operators, emergency services and community organisations are currently being notified of road closure times to ensure any difficulties are avoided well in advance of the event.

Due to the presence of emergency services at the start of each stage, residents along the course will be provided with near instant access to police, fire and ambulance services involved in the event should any emergency arise via the normal 000 emergency number.

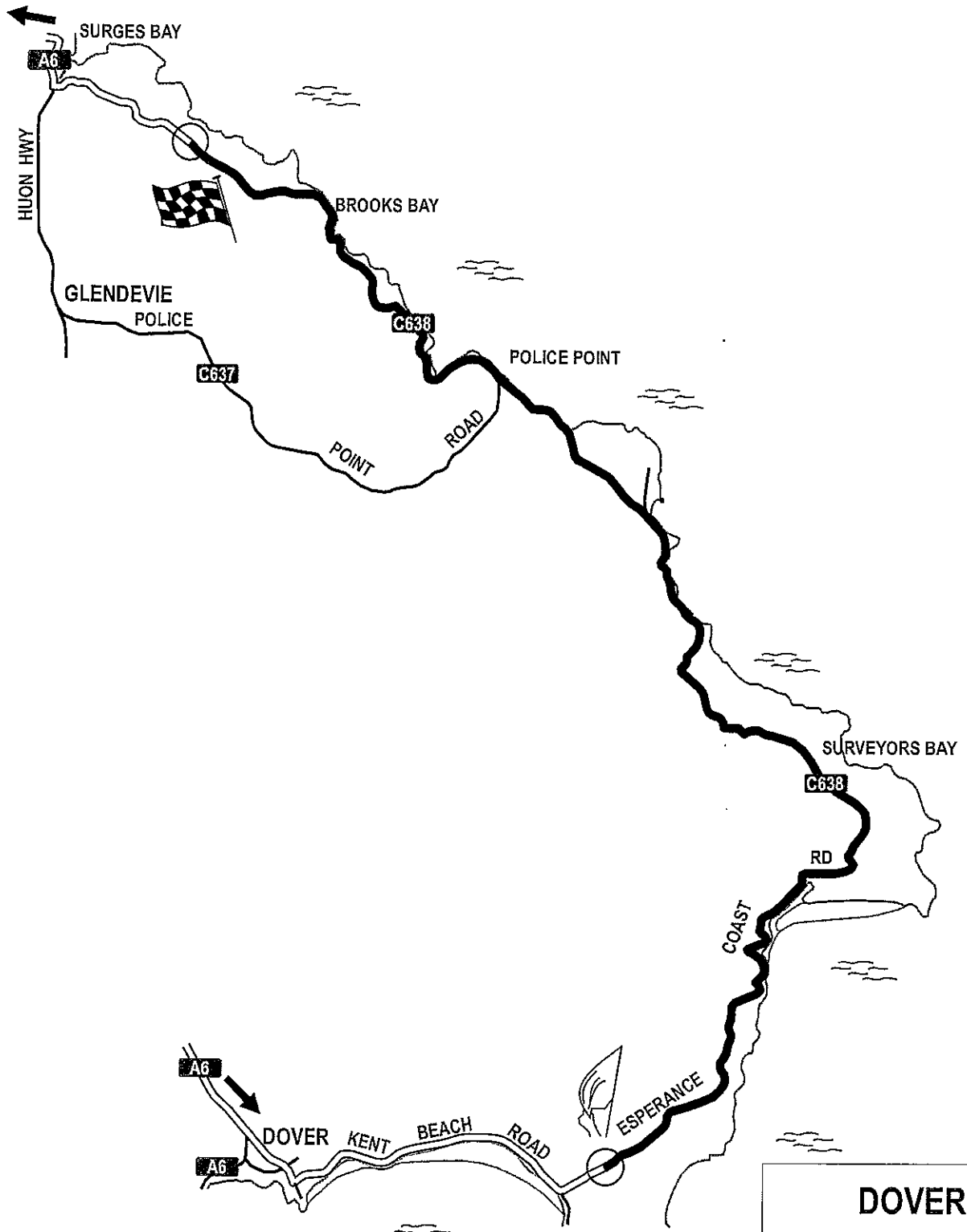


